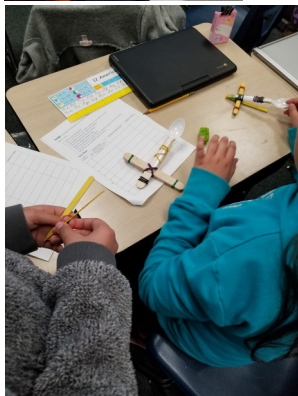
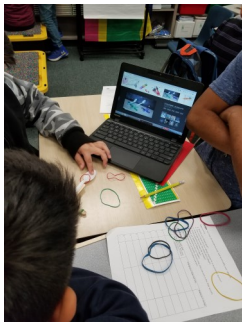


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Catapulting to success

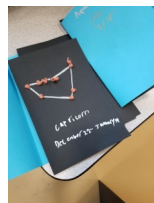
S.T.E.A.M. Saturday
