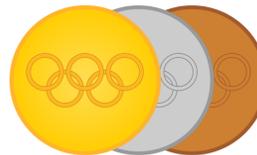
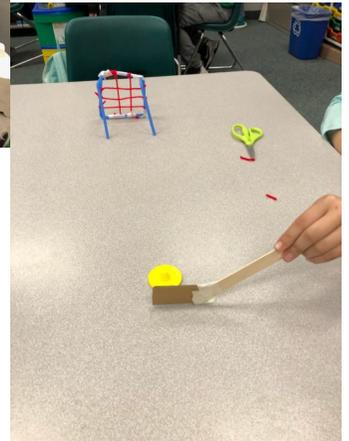
## County Spelling Bee
